UNFINISHED BUSINESS

2. Venable Park Memorial Jury Update

Lisa Hilton and Linda Kusmer provided an update on the progress of the Venable Park Memorial Jury. The jury reviewed the entries to the call for artists and selected three artists to move forward in the process and develop concept designs. Lisa Hilton stated the jury had also discussed the value of a piece of public art that is interactive versus figurative, with some jury members stating an interactive piece would create more discussion. Linda Kusmer stated the jury toured the park, which is a small residential park and would not be a good spot for a larger piece of art.

Melissa Bradford stated there would be a public review period in the coming months, and she would ask staff member Jason Valvero to send out an update to the jury



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members on next steps.

NEW BUSINESS

BUSINESS FROM MEMBERS

The Committee discussed the Sculpture on the Move program, suggesting asking if Public Works could reinstall the sculpture at the Shoppes at Westgate if the artist signed a liability waiver. The Committee also suggested having a committee member present during future artist installations.

Lisa Hilton stated the Little Art Gallery needs clips inside to prevent paper flying out when it's windy. Melissa Bradford said to send her any photos of the Little Art Gallery to be shared on its Instagram page.

Council liaison Sari Neudorf stated the city accepts applications for capital improvement projects each year that are valued at at least \$20,000, which could potentially be a source of funding for an Arts Committee project. Robert Morrissey suggested creating a sculpture garden near the wooded area next to Tappmeyer, and suggested committee members walk the parks to scope out other possible locations. The committee requested this item be added to the next meeting agenda.
