A public hearing and regular meeting of the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Creve Coeur, Missouri was held on Monday, December 17, 2012, at the Creve Coeur Government Center, 300 North New Ballas Road. Chair Tim Madden called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

2. ADDITIONS TO – ACCEPTANCE OF THE AGENDA

The Agenda was accepted as written.

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Draft Minutes of December 3, 2012

Mr. Eberhardt moved approval of the draft minutes with the exception of a minor correction to his motion, in regards to the application involving the sports court. Ms. Kramer seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

5. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

A. Application #12-033: A request for approval of the preliminary plat for 10 single family homes on four acres for the Villas at Mosley Subdivision with Residential Design Development (RDD) Designation

Mr. William Levinson, 42 Ladue Estates Drive, explained the concept of the project. Mr. Levinson explained the changes made to the application since the last Planning and Zoning meeting, stating the lot sizes, side-yard setbacks, and common ground size had all been made larger. Mr. Levinson also stated what public benefit he thought the project brought to Creve Coeur, including: a new housing option for residents wanting to downsize but remain in Creve Coeur; extensive common ground, including a reading garden; and a defined edge to the residential area along Mosley Road. Mr. Levinson believes the site is a good transition from commercial to residential. Mr. Levinson also addressed the concerns of the density issue, brought up by residents, stating fewer lots would not improve the view from Mosley Road since many of the lots would not be visible regardless of the total number. Mr. Levinson said the previous applicant received approval for 11 lots and that his proposal is for 10 lots, which is less dense than what was previously approved.

Mr. Rowdy Montgomery, Cadre Development, 10560 Old Olive Street Road, explained the property's history, as the representative of the land owner The Simms. Mr. Montgomery also represented the Simms with the Goddard School project. The Simms support the project because it seems achievable and they believe it is a sustainable use.

Mr. Richard Darrow, 812 N. Mosley Road, spoke neutrally about the project, however, he asked if the number of lots could be reduced to eight, if the privacy fencing could be cedar or something natural looking, and he expressed concerns with noises for the proposed walking pathway.

Ms. Ellen Lawrence, 501 N Mosley Road, spoke in opposition of the project and also submitted a signed and notarized petition for the record. Ms. Lawrence did state she believes the project does not fit the character of the neighborhood.

Mr. Mitch Waks, 429 N Mosley Road, spoke in opposition of the project and believes the proposal is too dense for the neighborhood.

Mr. Richard Meyer, 11210 Still Lane, spoke in opposition of the project. Mr. Meyer pointed out the previously approved project was for a larger parcel of land and the proposed project is too dense for the neighborhood. However, Mr. Meyer stated if the project is approved, he would like to see a site-proof fence installed. While Mr. Meyer believes RDD is a good concept for the city, he believes it is being stretched for this site.

Mr. David Caldwell, 257 Brooktrail Court, wanted to know since the previously approved project, if the lots sizes and common ground got bigger, what got smaller. Mr. Tim Meyer, Volz, Inc., stated the lots got bigger because common ground access was eliminated off the cul-de-sac. Mr. Tim Meyer does not believe the common ground area got bigger. Mr. Paul Langdon, Director of Community Development, City of Creve Coeur, stated there was some shifting of the common ground so the area along the south edge became common ground when it was previously private lots, and some of the larger lots lost ground to the small lots, but there was still the same amount of common ground.

Mr. Langdon addressed a couple of items, first the notion of a public amenity. Mr. Langdon stated that there is a requirement in the zoning code that states that, in a RDD, you must have

a reason for doing it and the reasoning must go to a larger purpose/public purpose. Mr. Langdon also addressed how a development can be a transition and how this proposal does represent one between the large residential lots to the south and the general commercial development to the north. Mr. Langdon gave some background and explained some scenarios.

Chairman Madden suggested taking the pathway out, adding more landscaping along Mosley Road, and installing a natural looking fence.

Dr. Barton asked about the forward facing garages and how it applies to this project and, also, if there was a creative way to not have so many forward facing garages. Mr. Langdon stated the design guidelines encourage rear or side facing garages, however, design guidelines are just guidelines there is no formal design review for residences in the city.

Chairman Madden asked if the Commission can tell them what material to use for the garages, and Mr. Langdon replied that the Commission could, but it can get overly prescriptive and then the garage door is driving the design of the house.

Mr. Eberhardt stated he does not believe the Commission should be telling builders what type of home to build. Mr. Eberhardt also said, in his opinion, if it is nine or 10 lots, it does not make a difference, the homes are fine quality. Mr. Eberhardt would like to see the pathway eliminated but to leave the greenspace as it still provides public benefit.

Mr. Faron asked if a reduction in homes was an option and to explain some similar developments in the city to compare. Mr. Langdon compared this situation to the Winfield Pointe subdivision.

Ms. Kramer asked Mr. Levinson to elaborate on the high quality standards. Mr. Levinson replied the designs are preliminary, but they are 2500-3500 square foot homes with brick exteriors, and prices ranging from a low of \$600,000 to mid \$700,000.

Chairman Madden asked about the fence type and Mr. Levinson asked the neighbors if they would want a fence or not if the path was eliminated. Mr. Darrow replied, yes they want a fence, as opposed to seeing other houses. Mr. Richard Meyer agreed. Mr. Levinson stated the homes on the lots will not be any closer than what exists but they will comply with the neighbors request for fencing. The Commission, staff and Mr. Levinson had several more minutes of discussion around the fence with the general conclusion that wood fencing would be installed along the south and west edges of the subdivision.

Ms. Kramer asked if there would be something around the basin to prevent any accidents from happening. Mr. Levinson replied the basin would not retain water more than a couple of days and that it would be built to MSD requirements, whatever they end up being.

The Commission and residents had more discussion around the fencing issue.

Mr. Scott McKenna, 805 Renee Lane, stated he was not opposed to the project, however, he is concerned about the basin and drainage issues. Mr. McKenna stated his backyard is a “gully” where the water runs to and sits. Chairman Madden replied that MSD has to approve the plans.

The Commission members discussed what they like and dislike about the project. In discussion, Mr. Levinson was asked if fewer homes would work. Mr. Levinson responded the project does not work for less than 10 homes. Mr. Langdon asked the Commission to be clear about the number of homes and greenspace area in their motion.

There being no more discussion, Mr. Eberhardt motioned to recommend approval of the Preliminary Plat for the Villas at Mosley subdivision submitted with Application #12-033, subject to the conditions contained in the draft ordinance attached to the staff report for the meeting of December 17, 2012, with the following additional conditions: 1) that the setbacks on the south side be moved to 30 feet on the rear setback, 2) that a wooden fence be constructed along the southern and eastern boundaries at such locations approved by the Director of Community Development and residents, and 3) that the walkway and garden be deleted and the greenspace remains. Mr. Faron seconded the motion with the resultant vote as follows:

Mr. Langdon explained the applicant will go before City Council on January 14, 2013, and that the denial vote from Planning and Zoning does not affect the voting rules for the Council.

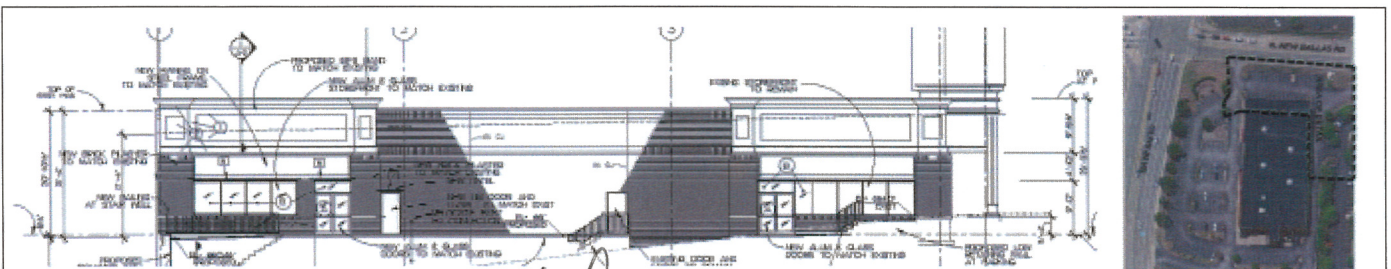

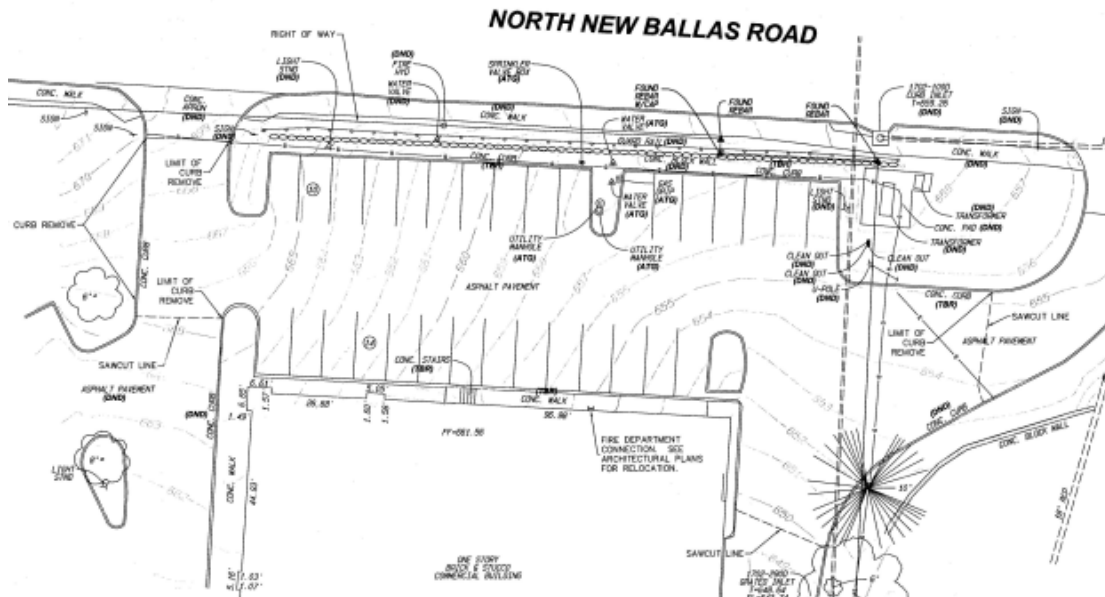

BACKGROUND AND REQUEST

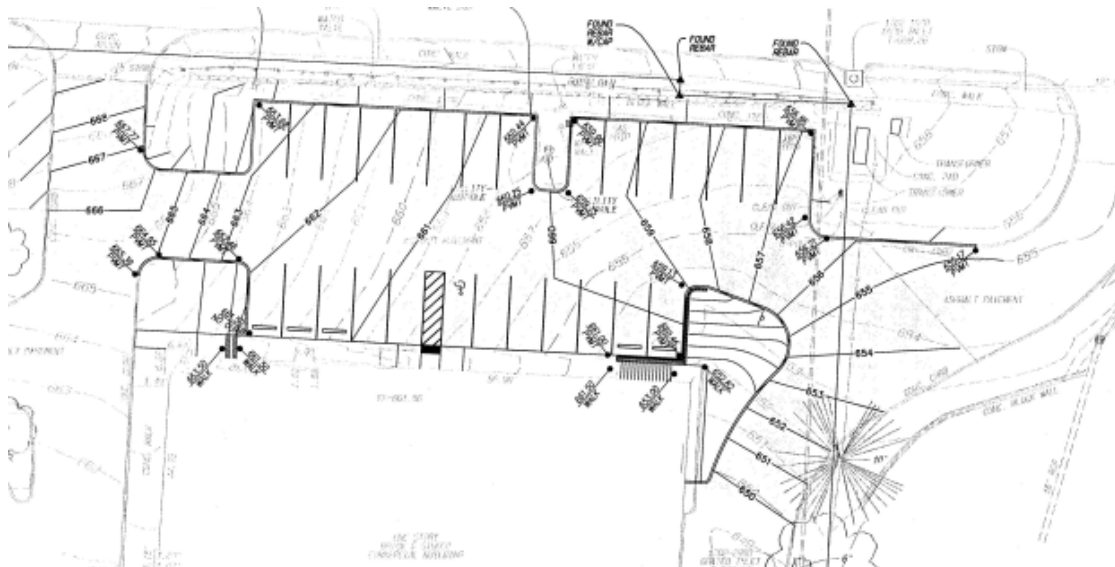
The property was originally developed in 1996 as a Borders Bookstore and has legally pre-existing non-conformities in regard to site coverage. Aldi Foods has leased the majority of the previous Border's space, and the applicant is seeking to create additional tenant spaces within the remaining space on the western end of the building.

The applicant proposes to re-grade the west parking lot by raising its elevation to the floor line of the building to allow for grade accessible parking to the new tenant space. This will also result in the creation of additional greenspace on the site. A landscape plan has not been submitted at this time.

Below is a close up of the existing grade and the proposed changes:

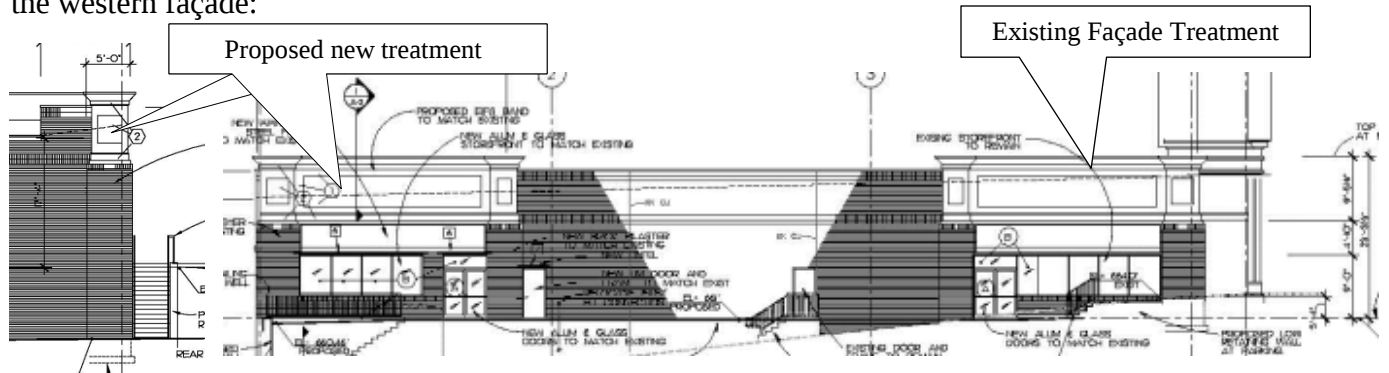


Existing Site Plan

The proposed façade improvements related to the proposed two tenant spaces along the western end of the building include matching the existing decorative element of the front end of the building to the northern corner and carrying the detail around the corner. COMPREHENSIVE PLAN REVIEW

The subject property is located in the Central Business District Action Area that encourages a mix of land uses and, in the area north of Olive Boulevard, encourages a continuation of the master-planned CityPlace Development. Adjacent developments should incorporate design elements, cross-access easements, pedestrian connections, and mixed uses. The addition of new tenants to the building and adding design elements and creating interest to what was a blank wall is consistent with this recommendation.

DESIGN GUIDELINES REVIEW

The Design Guidelines provide specific direction for the redevelopment of properties:

Chapter 2 / Buildings

C. Design

3. *The Primary building entrance should be clearly defined and provide a sense of entry. It should be oriented to the street and provide protection from the elements, such as recesses, roof overhangs, projecting canopies or other similar features.*
9. *Building elements, such as parapet walls, penthouses or screen walls should be treated as an integral part of the architecture, incorporating similar design, detail and materials as the primary structure. All rooftop equipment, including, but not limited to, satellite and other telecommunication equipment, air handling units, elevator equipment, cooling towers and exhaust fans are to be screened from view. Building screens should be part of the architectural design with similar detailing and materials and not appear as add-ons.*

E. Materials/Colors

- 1. Materials should have good architectural character, be durable, and be selected for their compatibility with adjoining building and properties. Natural, traditional building materials are encouraged. A preference should be given toward “green” building materials that can be recycled. Highly reflective and/or synthetic materials are discouraged.*
- 2. Exterior materials should be selected based on their durability and appropriateness for their intended function. Special attention should be given to the durability of materials used around the ground floor of the building. Preferred building materials include stone, brick, architectural precast concrete, aluminum and glass. The materials selected should require minimal maintenance. Their color should be integral to the materials and not be painted on.*
- 3. Exterior insulating finishing systems (EIFS) and concrete masonry should not be the predominant building materials. EIFS should be used as a way to accentuate an architectural element and should be limited to area not subject to damage or abuse. Concrete masonry should be limited to split face or burnished units.*

The design character of the building is pre-existing with the current EIFS detailing along the south and southwest corner of the building. The addition of more EIFS would, in general, not meet with the Design Guidelines. However, the overall intent is met by adding detail that matches the existing to the northwest corner of the building and creating the interest along the façade and wrapping around the building corner.

ZONING CODE REVIEW

Staff has reviewed the grading plan with the Director of Public Works and the City Engineer and, while the grading of the new parking area is not optimal, Staff is satisfied that it is the best grading option of this area, and will meet with ADA guidelines for access to the new tenant space. However, raising the parking lot will largely eliminate the screening of the parking from N. New Ballas Road. A condition of approval includes that a landscape plan be submitted to meet with the requirements of Section 405.810(5) Screening and Landscaping of Article VII Off-Street Parking and Loading Regulations below:

SECTION 405.810: DESIGN AND MAINTENANCE STANDARDS

- 5. Screening and landscaping.**
 - a. All parking and loading areas shall be landscaped and provide screening in accordance with all applicable requirements of Section 405.540, Landscaping.*
 - b. All parking adjoining a residential use or public right-of-way, except for those associated with single-family and two-family residences, shall be screened from view by an earth berm, a solid wall, decorative fence, evergreen planting of equivalent visual density or other effective means. Such fence or berm and associated landscaping shall be a minimum of eighteen (18) inches in height and an average of three (3) feet in height at the time of planting. Screening shall be a minimum of six (6) feet in height between the parking lot and any other abutting residential property line. The Planning and Zoning Commission may require greater screening requirements for parking of large trucks, the screening of large equipment and utility structures and for screening overhead doors and truck loading areas and docks.*

RECOMMENDED CONDITION OF APPROVAL

If Commission members generally support the request, staff recommends the following conditions for approval:

- The applicant is required to submit a Site Improvement Permit application, showing all exterior improvements, as required by Section 420.070 of the Land Disturbance Code. The permit application shall be in substantial conformance with the “Site/Grading Plan & Details” received January 3, 2013, as bound together and submitted in conjunction with Application #12-044 by Robert Hembrock, of GPS, Glasper Professional Services Engineers/Surveyors.
- The Applicant is required to submit a Building Permit application, as required by Article II of the Building Code. Exterior elevations shall be in substantial conformance with the “Exterior Elevations” dated December 14, 2012 and the revised North Elevation received January 3, 2012, as bound together and submitted in conjunction with Application #12-044 by John Lark, of John Lark and Associates architects and Planners.
- The Applicant shall submit a landscape plan to meet with the requirements of Section 405.810(5) Screening and Landscaping of Article VII Off-Street Parking and Loading Regulations and Section 405.540 Landscaping for the Zoning Administrator’s approval.

ACTION AND MOTION

The motion to approve site development plans and landscape plans as shown in the Applicant’s materials will be in the form of approval, approval with conditions, denial or deferral. Section 405.370 (G)(1) states that any development and/or redevelopment plans for properties within the area bounded by the City limit on the north, Olive Blvd, on the south, Craig Rd. on the east and I-270 on the west, requires Planning and Zoning Commission and City Council review and approval. The following is an example of an appropriate motion for this application:

“I move to recommend approval for the site plan and elevations for the renovation of the west parking area and northwest corner of the building at 11733 Olive Boulevard submitted with Application #12-044, as presented to the Planning and Zoning Commission and according to the draft resolution attached to the staff report prepared for the meeting of January 7, 2013” (if so desired; conditions may be added by separate motion).

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A BUILDING PLAN AND SITE/ GRADING IMPROVEMENT
PLANS FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE BUILDING LOCATED AT 11733 OLIVE
BOULEVARD**

WHEREAS, Section 405.370 (G)(1) of the Municipal Code states that any development and/or redevelopment plans for properties within the area bounded by the City limit on the north, Olive Blvd, on the south, Craig Rd. on the east and I-270 on the west, requires Planning and Zoning Commission and City Council review and approval; and

WHEREAS, an application was submitted by John Lark of John Lark and Associates, on behalf of Mid-County Real Estate, LLC., for approval of a minor site development plan for parking lot improvements and building façade changes that create new tenant space on the northwest corner of the building, including regrading of the parking lot to bring the area up to the building floor level to allow for ADA access to the new tenant space; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission reviewed and, by a ____ vote, recommended approval of the request, subject to the conditions contained herein, at its meeting on January 7, 2013; and

WHEREAS, all parties desiring to be heard, either for or against said application, were given an opportunity to be heard, and a copy of the proposed resolution has been made available for public inspection prior to its consideration by the Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the application and evidence presented clearly indicate that the proposed Site Development Plan, when subject to certain conditions set forth herein:

1. Complies with all other applicable provisions of this Chapter including environmental performance standards presented in Section 405.550, the criteria in Section 405.470 and the standards of this Chapter in regard to yard and setback, parking and loading areas, screening and buffering, refuse, storage and service areas and signs.
2. Will contribute to and promote the community welfare and convenience at the specific location.
3. Will not cause substantial injury to the value of neighboring property.
4. Meets the applicable provisions of the City's Comprehensive Plan and any applicable neighborhood or sector plans and complies with other applicable zoning district regulations and provisions of this Chapter, unless good cause exists for deviation there from.
5. Will provide, if applicable, erosion control and on-site stormwater detention in accordance with the standards contained in this Chapter.
6. Will be compatible with the surrounding area and thus will not impose an excessive burden or have a substantial negative impact on surrounding or adjacent users or on community facilities or services.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Creve Coeur, St. Louis County, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1: The Site Development Plan is approved subject to the following conditions:

1. The applicant is required to submit a Site Improvement Permit application, showing all exterior improvements, as required by Section 420.070 of the Land Disturbance Code. The permit application shall be in substantial conformance with the "Site/Grading Plan &

Details” received January 3, 2013, as bound together and submitted in conjunction with Application #12-044 by Robert Hembrook, of GPS, Glasper Professional Services Engineers/Surveyors.

2. The Applicant is required to submit a Building Permit application, as required by Article II of the Building Code. Exterior elevations shall be in substantial conformance with the “Exterior Elevations” dated December 14, 2012 and the revised North Elevation received January 3, 2012, as bound together and submitted in conjunction with Application #12-044 by John Lark, of John Lark and Associates architects and Planners.
3. The Applicant shall submit a landscape plan to meet with the requirements of Section 405.810(5) Screening and Landscaping of Article VII Off-Street Parking and Loading Regulations and Section 405.540 Landscaping for the Zoning Administrator’s approval.
4. Grading and construction shall not commence until all required approvals and permits have been obtained.

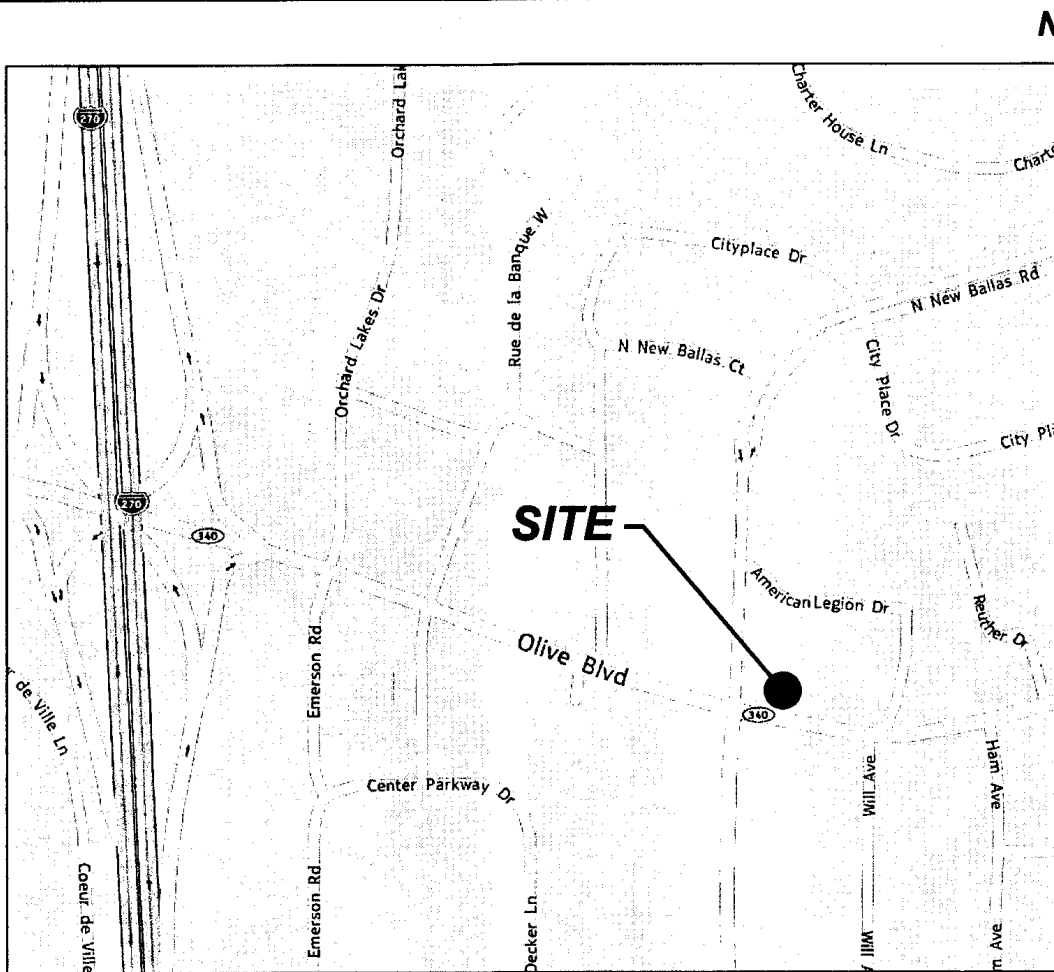

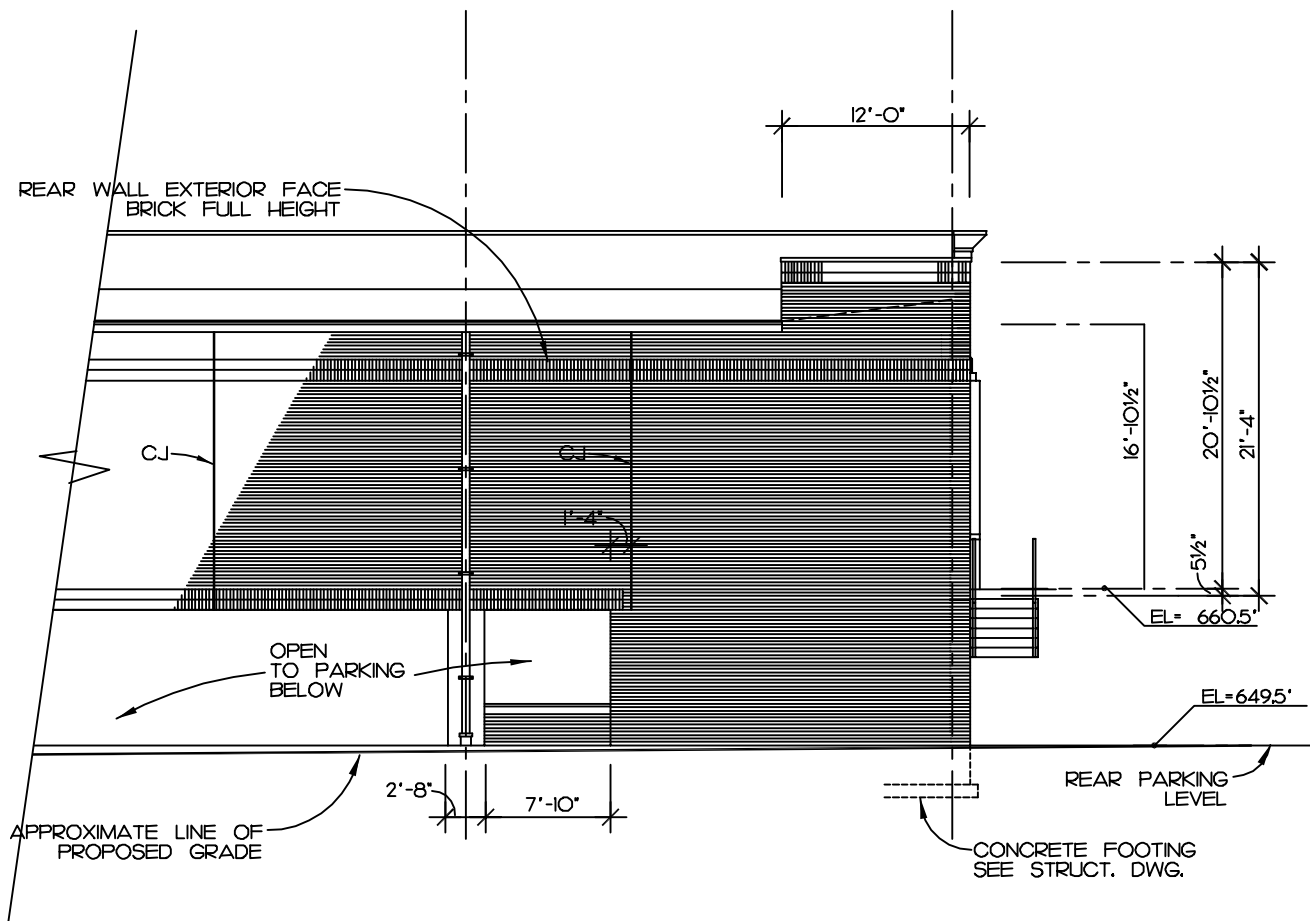

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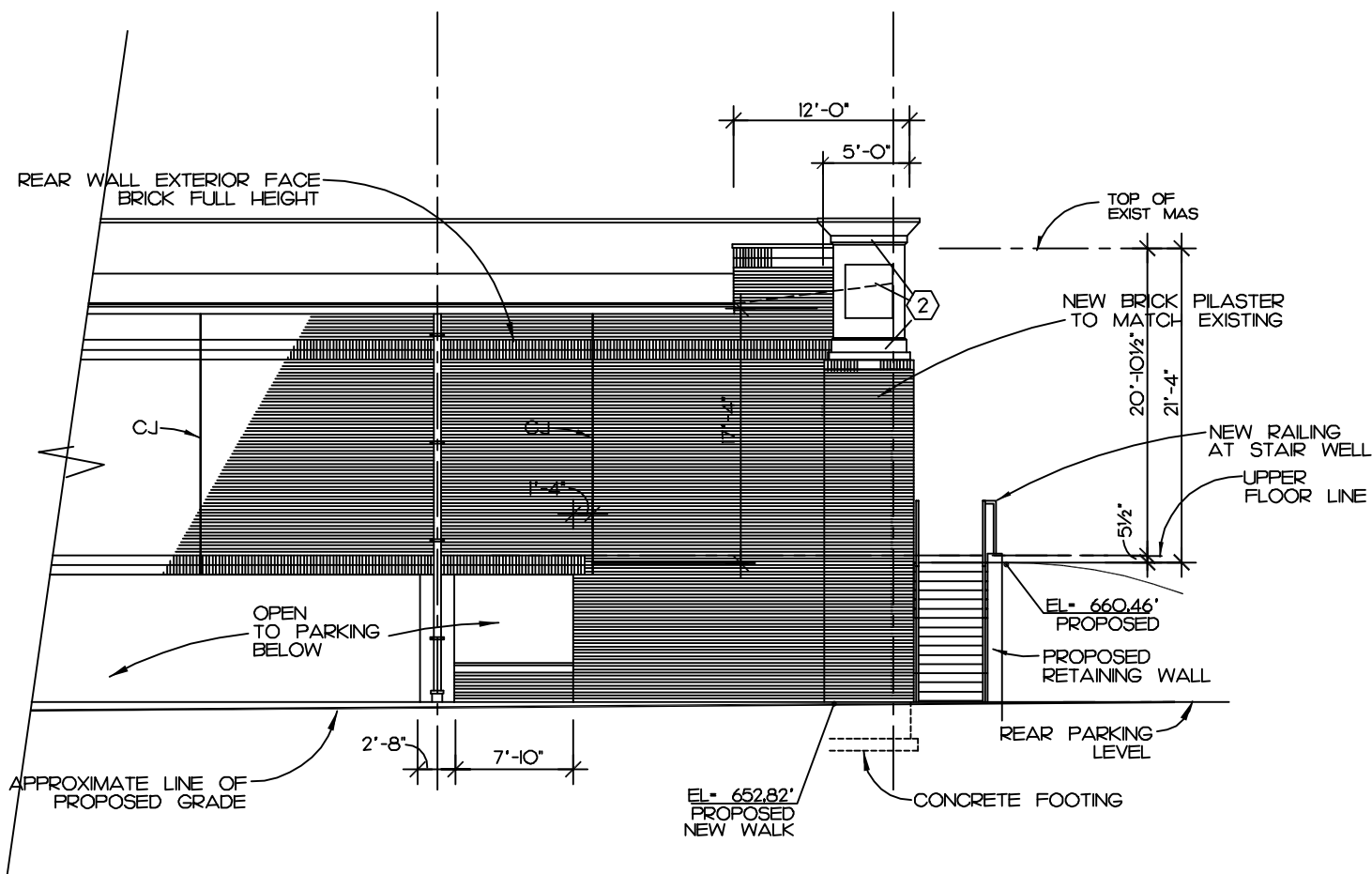

Members of the Commission,

The proposed plan for modifications to the west parking lot and western building façade have been brought about due to the closure of the Borders Books facility which occupied this building since it was built in 1996. The vacation of Borders has left the majority of the building empty for the past year while new tenants were sought.

Aldi Foods has leased the center portion of the previous Border's space, but approximately 10,000 sf remains on the western end of the building. While previously the grade condition of the parking lot on the west side was not an issue as overflow parking, it has become central to the ability of the Owner to lease this remaining space. There is interest in a 7500 sf lease of the building's southeast corner, but there is concern for customers accessibility to safely access the space. In addition, the remaining 2500 sf at the Northwest corner would be elevated high above the current parking lot limiting potential to lease the remaining space.

To resolve this issue, and to make the western side of the building attractive for potential lease, we propose a modification to the parking lot and building façade as follows:

Lot: The grade of the existing west parking lot is proposed to be modified raising it's elevation to near the floor line of the building. The transition from the south entrance drive, and the north drive to the rear parking would be met by providing retaining walls and larger planter islands resulting in a loss of four (4) cars on the west lot. The new parking lot configuration provides direct grade accessible parking to the upper floor line of the building.

Façade: As a part of the modification, we propose to provide a new storefront and entrance for the Northwest (rear) corner of the building with access to the western parking lot as modified. The façade change would duplicate the existing corner façade at the Southwest corner of the building providing two lease area facades and signage areas.

We respectfully submit this application for Amendment to the Site Development Plan for Mid-County Real Estate Real Estate, LLC.

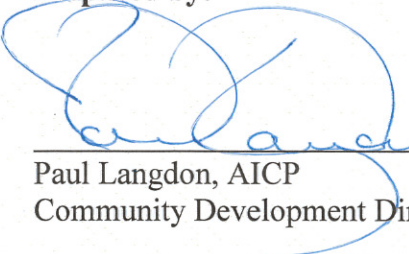

Introduction

The SIC to NAICS zoning code revisions were first discussed at the July 2, 2012 Commission work session. At that time, the Commission requested to review the code changes in segments. As requested, the residential districts were reviewed on August 6th; the "HE" Higher Education, "PH" Planned Hospital, "PO" Planned Office and "RO" Research Office zoning districts were discussed on November 5th; and the "MX" Mixed Use and "PC" Planned Community zoning districts were reviewed on December 17th. Attached to this report is the table of uses for only the "GC" General Commercial since this district allows such a broad spectrum of uses and includes many visible properties and areas where residential impacts are of key concern.

The Commission should note that a 2012 update of the NAICS is currently available and once the changes from the SIC to the 2002 NAICS codes are acceptable, an update to the 2012 NAICS codes is more easily done.

Major Changes

a. Transferable updates

In general, permitted and conditional uses that are currently in the municipal code were updated to reflect the new 2002 NAICS classification code numbers. These

updates are shown as P for permitted use, or C for conditional use. NAICS codes were also given to uses that were explicitly not permitted; these changes are highlighted in red and noted by "NO." While the structure of the code does not require listing of not-permitted uses (anything not included is not permitted), staff wanted it to be clear to the Commission where undesirable uses were falling under new codes and would still being excluded unless directed otherwise.

- b. *Assignment of number codes to existing permitted and conditional uses expressed in language form*
Changes made to permitted and conditional uses that were originally denoted in language form in the zoning district regulations were updated by assigning the appropriate NAICS code to those uses; these changes are highlighted in yellow.
- c. *New industry classification codes with additional conditional and permitted uses*
The 2002 NAICS codes include new industries and provides unique numbers to industries that were previously classified under a broader SIC code. These updates are shown as a P for permitted use or C for conditional use under their respective district and are highlighted in green.
- d. *Uses requiring special consideration*
A small number of uses (banking and used auto sales) are currently permitted subject to specific caveats that do not translate into any industry category. Due to space limitations in the table, the caveats are not written out but staff wanted the Commission to be alerted to those issues and have highlighted them in purple.
- e. *Changes in permitted and conditional uses*
A small number of previously permitted and conditional uses are proposed for elimination and these changes are denoted with an X and are also highlighted in red.

Recommended Action

The Commission is asked to review this portion of the overall update and provide comments as necessary. Following the "GC" review, staff will return to the Commission at a future meeting with the "CB" Core Business and "LI" Light Industrial zoning districts for similar consideration. Once the concerns have been adequately addressed for all of the zoning districts, a public hearing will be scheduled and a formal amendment to the Zoning Code will be pursued.
