UNFINISHED BUSINESS

2. Three Sculptures by Shawn Burkhard

Robert Morrissey presented a draft report for the committee's feedback. The draft report explains the reasoning for the committee's recommendation for deaccession of the three sculptures by Shawn Burkhard. Scott Saunders recommended the report specifically cite criteria from the Public Arts Master Plan. The Committee agreed the justification for deaccession was that "the artwork was deemed to have little or no aesthetic, historical and/or cultural value" and "the artwork condition requires restoration beyond its aesthetic value or the City's resources to restore it."

Part of the deaccession policy is to advertise a public meeting about the deaccession proposal. Scott Saunders suggested putting the announcement in the next two newsletters. The Committee agreed to host the public meeting at the Arts Committee



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meeting on December 12th. Comments can be sent in via email or in person at the public meeting. Robert Morrissey stated he would check in with the art gallery that represents the artist to see if the sculptures had an estimated cost.

BUSINESS FROM MEMBERS

Lisa Hilton provided an update on the Free Little Art Gallery (FLAG), stating the gallery is usually empty. Melissa Bradford suggested putting this item on future agendas to discuss ways to market the FLAG. Pier Alsup asked if a list of upcoming projects and project timelines could be provided at future meetings. Melissa Bradford stated she could provide that information with future agendas. Committee members suggested having a brainstorm meeting in January to brainstorm new project ideas.
