NEW BUSINESS

2. Public Art Proposal: Saleeby & Associates, Inc.

Raymond Saleeby presented his proposal for a public art installation on the property of his business, Saleeby & Associates, Inc., located at 11301 Olive Blvd. Their proposal included plans for landscaping and solar lighting around the sculpture. Arts Committee



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members spoke favorably of the artwork, stating it would be a visual asset to Creve Coeur and the installation site was well-suited for the sculpture. Arts Committee members noted the bull-shaped grill also present on the property; they discussed whether the grill and the sculpture would visually compete with each other and came to a consensus that the grill was not a concern since it was far enough away from the sculpture site.

The Arts Committee voted to recommend the public art proposal from Saleeby & Associates, Inc., with the additional recommendation that low level lighting be used and placed around the sculpture in a manner that does not reflect light into the vision of drivers along Olive Boulevard.
