2. Energy & Environment Pages on Website

Melissa Bradford stated that the city just implemented a new website chatbot named CiCi. The chatbot uses information on the website to answer questions from visitors, making it an ideal time to review and update the Energy & Environment Committee pages.

The Committee reviewed and discussed subpages of the Energy & Environment Committee portion of the website. Committee members each volunteered to look subpages for Quick and Effective Conservation Tips and bring their edits to the next meeting. The Committee agreed to remove the Creve Coeur Heroes webpages, which

were from an initiative over ten years ago. Tarab suggested adding photos to pages, such as a photo of the electronics recycling event. The Committee agreed to make the Climate Action Plan its own subpage. The Committee agreed to remove the Useful Links at a later date, because a page of hyperlinks is not practical way to share information.

3. Newsletter Articles

Melissa Bradford stated that Andy's article will be published in the November newsletter. The Committee agreed to have an article in the December newsletter summarizing the results of the electronics recycling event. Tarab suggested adding a graphic to the E&E webpages promoting upcoming events like recycling events and Arbor Day.

4. Climate Action Plan

The Committee reviewed the actions from the CAP Phase 3, noting that many have been completed, including (1) publishing the CAP Phase 3, (2) studying potential for EVs in city fleets, and (3) implementing smart lighting practices using lights at 3000K or less. For future actions, Tarab suggested looking into Ripple Glas containers for Creve Coeur where people can recycle glass. Andy suggested having the Mayor sign the Mayors Climate Protection Agreement. Melissa stated that Council liaison Donna Spence had suggested the Green Cities Challenge.
