The Committee discussed the upcoming Plein Air Art Event.

Melissa Bradford stated that the committee will need to determine how the "People's Choice Award" will be determined. The Committee recommended having a designated person hand out paper slips and explain what they are for. The paper slips would be a certain color with the event logo on it. Another person would be responsible for the bucket to collect the votes. There would be a cutoff time to submit your vote. The two committee members would be responsible for counting the votes.

One designated committee member could promote the event on stage before the performance and at intermission.

There could also be a tent outside the Tappmeyer House to draw attention to the event, with a sign that says "Art Show." There could be yard signs that say "Art Show, Free Entry" with an arrow throughout the park.

Sponsors should be encouraged to share the event flyer with their audience. The Committee will continue to consider ways to promote the event to the public.
