A. Review of Website Updates

Melissa Orscheln reviewed the updates made to the City website based on the suggestions of the Arts Committee during the June 2020 committee meeting. The website menu and homepage were updated to make it easier for visitors to find information about joining a citizen board, committee or commission.

The Arts Committee discussed the new member appointment process and Nominating Committee meeting process.

B. Discussion of Future Project Ideas

The Arts Committee discussed future project ideas for the committee, keeping in mind the safety challenges presented by COVID-19 and limits to in-person gatherings. The Committee agreed that any future projects should not involve in-person interaction to avoid the risk of spreading COVID-19. The project would ideally have a high impact to the community for a low cost.

Suggested ideas included:



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- Working with local businesses to solicit artists for storefront installations
- Installing temporary art in the government center lobby
- Soliciting artists to create a "growing sculpture" from recycled materials
- Drive-by temporary art installation on a commercial lot
- Artistic face mask contest
- Temporary or traveling wall with rotating graffiti art
- "Paint for Peace" display at Dr. H. Phillip Venable Memorial Park (if available)
- Music performance via Zoom in partnership with local schools
- Temporary art installation outside of the Mercy construction site honoring frontline medical professionals

The Committee further discussed the idea of having a temporary art installation outside of the Mercy Hospital construction site, in partnership with Mercy. The fencing/boards surrounding the construction site could be painted/graffitied by a commissioned artist, and the theme of the art piece would be honoring and thanking frontline medical professionals during the COVID-19 pandemic. Melissa Orscheln agreed to discuss the proposed idea with staff.
