B. Invasive Weeds Action Ideas

- Jim Graham discussed importance of continuing discussion and educating the public about invasive plants. Committee discussed having a representative from Missouri Department of Conservation or Missouri Botanical Garden to present topic at a future City Council Work Session. Work Session topic would focus on invasives, importance of ongoing management practices, and replacement of invasives with natives plants and grasses. Jim reminded the committee that the City of Columbia has a "Stop the Spread Campaign".
- Committee discussed importance of city support to assist in clearing invasives by dedicating staff time or funding. Options included using contractors to clear areas and replacement with native grasses to develop a management program.
- Jim will start developing a plan for a specific area for management. He will distribute to committee members for comments/additions before the next meeting.
- Committee discussed a possible landscaping project in front of the Creve Coeur Government Center.

Fran Cantor moved, seconded by Claire Chosid to develop a landscaping plan in front of the Creve Coeur Government Center. Motion approved unanimously.
