A. Landscaping around bus shelter discussion with Arts Committee

Discussion item was moved to the end of the meeting. Arts Committee staff liaison Melissa Orscheln explained the project proposed by the Arts Committee regarding the Window Tree bus shelter on Olive Boulevard. The Arts Committee would like to work with the property owner to remove the large burning bushes, and then potentially do additional landscaping around the bus shelter.

The Committee recommended that the bushes be removed by December and proposed the Arts Committee returns to a future HEB meeting in January to discuss landscaping. Mara Berry suggested applying for a grant from Forest ReLeaf of Missouri and offered to assist with grant writing.

Rachel Eilbott agreed to work with staff liaison to update the school contacts spreadsheet. Staff liaison agreed to send the Arbor Day flyer to the committees who have helped with the event in the past.
