Minutes Acceptance: Minutes of Nov 10, 2021 4:30 PM (Approval of Minutes)



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A. Revision of CityTree Ordinance

Resident, Lynn Berry met with the Committee to discuss a revision/modification to the City's current Tree Conservation Ordinance Section 410.320. Also present was Director of Community Development Jason Jaggi.

Ms. Berry distributed to the Committee a printed copy of her power point presentation that had been shared with the Mayor and Council during the September 27, 2021 Council Meeting. The presentation focused on a residential project that was occurring across the street from her residence. Because Ms. Berry felt the project eliminated so many trees and in her opinion the current City Ordinance was not sufficient, she suggested the City develop a more detailed conservation Tree Ordinance to be similar to other neighboring cities.

Jason Jaggi provided the Committee with detailed information on the current City Ordinance and specifically how it related to the project from Ms. Berry's presentation. Mr. Jaggi also explained to the Committee the amount of resources needed to manage and oversee a detailed Tree Ordinance such as those suggested by Ms. Berry from other municipalities.

Although the Committee was in support of an update/revision of the current ordinance, they also were in agreement this would be a huge undertaking for the City. It was pointed out that this could be developed in stages and over time which the Committee was in favor of recommending.

Mr. Jaggi indicated that on December 6, Planning & Zoning will meet with Council to discuss a list of the top priorities at which time Mr. Jaggi will mention this project at the meeting. Janet Rueschhoff will follow up with the Committee as soon as the information is available.

B. Arbor Day Discussion

The Date: April 24, 2022 is preferred. May 1st is alternate. Janet will make the necessary Park reservations.

Theme: Nature Around Us

The Committee will promote the Art Contest as in past years. Janet will ask if the Art Committee will be interested in judging the entries. Mara and Janet will work on notifying the area schools regarding the Art Contest as well as other advertising sites.

Other City Committees will be invited to set up their tables and be present during the event. The Committee will need to contact other vendors to be a part of the day and it was mentioned that in past years a photo booth was on site.

Mara shared with the committee a "kids activity" of an Arbor Day "passport" where the kids could go from one activity to the next to complete their card. Janet will ask the Public Information Officer to help with a mock up to show the committee for approval.

Janet will order the contest ribbons and participation ribbons for the event. It was discussed to have the year and "theme" left off the ribbons so they could be used for future events.
