A. Sculpture on the Move 2021

Staff liaison Melissa Orscheln provided an update on the Sculpture on the Move program for 2021, stating that the next steps for the sculpture located at LaVerne Collins Park will be to add the landscaping recommended by the Horticulture, Ecology and Beautification Committee. Landscaping will be completed in the fall.

B. Mercy Mural Project

Staff liaison Melissa Orscheln presented a draft RFQ for artists for the proposed Mercy "mural" project to commission an artist to create a healthcare-related design that would be printed on vinyl fencing surrounding Mercy's construction site, with the goal to recognize healthcare workers and get the community engaged in public art. The Committee reviewed and discussed the draft together. Melissa Orscheln stated the next step is to send the final draft to Mercy for review.

C. Future Brainstorming Meeting

The Committee agreed to focus on brainstorming new ideas at a future meeting when convenient for all members.

Lisa Hilton provided an update on the BJC public art proposal, stating she and city staff walked around the proposed location with BJC staff to discuss the placement of the sculpture. BJC plans to prepare a revised presentation for the Arts Committee to review in the near future.
