**VI. New Business**

***A. Parks and Stormwater Tax***

Staff is currently assessing the repairs and improvements needed for its parks and plans to complete this assessment by the end of 2016.

The update to the City's stormwater master plan report and several known stormwater projects will serve as the basis for the City's stormwater needs. Staff plans to refine the costs associated with these needs by the end of 2016.

Staff recommends that the Committee consider waiting until the completion of these assessments prior to discussion of pursuing a new parks and stormwater tax.

***i. Driveway Bridge at 26 Balcon Estates***

The homeowner has applied for a site development permit for the rehabilitation of the base of her driveway bridge and the downstream channel.

***i. Alden Lane Culvert***



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This project involves the extension of a box culvert beneath Alden Lane to address a failing wingwall and other issues there. Construction plans for this project have received MSD approval. Staff is working through the final details of the project with Reitz & Jens, Inc., the City's engineering consultant for the project. Staff anticipates construction of this project during the winter and spring.

**ii. Dam Stabilization**

The City Council authorized the execution of a contract with Kuesel Excavating, Inc., for a project to partially reconstruct the dam at the Creve Coeur Golf Course and to deepen the pond that is retained by the dam. The contract sum for the project is \$169,434.30, which is well within the budget for the project.

Kuesel plans to begin the project in December and expects the project to take about one month to complete.

**iii. Parks Bridge Replacements**

Staff recently learned that the bridge at Malcolm Terrace Park qualifies for a preliminary engineering review through MoDOT's Bridge Engineering Assistance Program. This program provides this review at no cost to the City. Staff expects the results of this review by the end of 2016.

**iv. Minor Stormwater Projects**

Solutions to several localized issues are currently under review. Staff will review these with the Committee.
