A. Stormwater Concerns Update

Staff will update the Committee regarding stormwater concerns that have developed in the City's parks and along the City's rights of way.

i. Middlebrook Drive Culvert Rehabilitation

Staff is currently reviewing the final design plans and easement documents for this project. A copy of the plans will be available at the meeting for discussion.

ii. Sherwyn Lane Cul-de-Sac

Intuition & Logic provided a proposal to review the stormwater situation at the Sherwyn Lane cul de sac and to design a solution to it. Staff presented this proposal to the City Council at their meeting on March 26, and the City Council requested that staff return to the City Council for additional discussion at their meeting on April 23.

The City Council was wary of entering into a design contract to evaluate possibly adding a storm drain to a street. The Council asked that the design be limited to the evaluation phase and that staff request that MSD consider adding a drain, if that is what is found to be necessary.



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C. Citizen Survey

The City is preparing to issue a survey to the residents of Creve Coeur that seeks opinions about the City's services. The Stormwater Committee requested that the survey include several questions regarding stormwater. After consideration, the City Council approved a draft survey that included two questions related to stormwater:
