5. New Business

A. Barnes-Jewish West County Hospital Public Art Proposal

Nancy Coleman introduced the art proposal for a sculpture at Barnes-Jewish West County Hospital located at 12634 Olive Blvd.

Lisa Hilton asked what the City requires regarding the art proposal. Jason Jaggi stated that the art proposal is part of a conditional use permit and site plan to incorporate public art on the Barnes-Jewish West County Hospital. The CUP required that the sculpture be integrated into the site with pedestrian linkages. Following the Arts Committee's recommendation, the Planning and Zoning Commission will have final review of the proposal.

Mary Walsh provided background information on the artist, Jeff Kahn.

Stephen Wheeler described the kinetic sculpture, stating it is approximately 15 feet tall and clarifying that the moving parts move slowly even in high winds.

The Arts Committee reviewed and discussed the two options presented. Both options included landscaping, public seating, and a path connecting the site to the main sidewalk. Option 1 had a small square base for the sculpture, and Option 2 had a triangle base with a larger circular border. The Committee agreed that Option 2 was preferred.

Scott Saunders recommended adding signage at the sculpture site with the sculpture/artist name. Lisa Hilton asked if Option 2 had enough walking space, and Stephen Wheeler confirmed it was ADA Compliant.

Lisa Hilton suggested the Arts Committee seek out opportunities to collaborate with other committees on projects that may overlap with the arts.
