**A. Stormwater Concerns Update**

Staff will provide a summary for each stormwater concern that has been reviewed since the March Stormwater Committee meeting.

**i. Pipe Condition, Erosion, Flooding - Ferntop Lane**

The resident at 12958 Ferntop Lane (Melissa Inkley) is concerned about the condition of the storm drain that runs beneath her yard, and the resident at 12970 Ferntop Lane (Jim Hearne) is concerned about erosion behind his home and flash flooding that impacted his home in August.

Mrs. Inkley plans to make a presentation to the Stormwater Committee.



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**ii. Runoff and Ponding - Hibler Woods**

The resident at 416 Hibler Woods Court (Dorgan) addressed the Stormwater Committee in February. Staff met with Mr. Dorgan in March.

**iii. Stream Bank Erosion - Villa Coublay**

The resident at 60 Villa Coublay Drive (Hunter) is concerned about bank erosion along Deer Creek its impacts to his property.

***B. Capital Improvement Program***

The City Council is scheduled to consider adoption of the Capital Improvement Program (CIP) at their meeting on Monday, April 12. Once the CIP is adopted, staff will begin preparations for the projects listed in FY2022 of the CIP. Stormwater projects scheduled in FY2022 of the CIP are:

1. Stormwater Management Study - Scope review
2. Hibler Roadside Drainage - Design
3. Alden Lane Drain Replacement - Design and Construction
4. Ballas Culvert Erosion Rehabilitation - Design
5. Golf Course Pond Aeration - Design and Construction

***C. Stormwater Projects Update***

**i. Spoede at Ladue (MSD)**

MSD's contractor has nearly completed the project to improve the stormwater system and restore the road and sidewalk at the intersection of Ladue Road at Spoede Road. Staff will share photos of their progress.

***A. Purchasing Policy (Judy Campbell)***

Judy Campbell requested a summary of the City's process for soliciting and hiring engineering firms. Staff will discuss the City's qualifications-based selection process for professional services.
