4. New Business

A. Public Art Proposal from Saleeby & Associates

Ray Saleeby of Saleeby & Associates, Inc., presented a public art proposal for his business located at 11301 Olive Blvd.

Ray Saleeby stated that he purchased the sculpture at an auction and plans to install the sculpture on the west side of the building. Created in 1971 by artist Charles Owen Perry, the proposed sculpture is titled Cruciform, is made of chrome-plated bronze, and is approximately 10 feet tall and 7 feet wide.

Lisa Hilton asked if a concrete pad will be installed, and Ray Saleeby confirmed a concrete pad will be installed.

Lisa Hilton asked if lighting will be installed around the sculpture. Ray Saleeby stated he had not considered lighting yet.

Jason Jaggi asked if the bull figure located on the side of the building would be removed. Ray Saleeby stated the bull on the side of the building is an outdoor grill, clarifying it is not the same bull sculpture that he presented to the City several years ago. The bull sculpture that was presented to the City several years ago and denied is now located inside his office building.

Lisa Hilton stated the proposed sculpture would be a beautiful and welcome addition to the city.



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Ray Saleeby stated he wanted to ensure kids do not play on the sculpture. The Committee suggested additions such as a concrete border or landscaped border around the sculpture to discourage people from getting too close.

The Committee voted to recommend the addition of this public art piece to the City. Sara Friedman moved, Scott Saunders seconded. All voted in favor, motion passed unanimously.

Director of Community Development Jason Jaggi stated the next steps will be to submit a revised site plan to the Planning and Zoning Commission, which may include more details about any proposed lighting and landscaping.

The Committee discussed the juxtaposition of the bull BBQ grill and the proposed sculpture. Scott Saunders stated the bull figure visually detracts from the sculpture in his opinion, and suggested that the grill be relocated so that the new sculpture is the focal point and not visually competing with the grill.

The Committee thanked Ray Saleeby for his public art proposal.
