4. New Business

A. Arbor Day Art Contest Judging

The Committee judged the Arbor Day art contest entries and discussed what to have at its booth during the event, such as a flyer with info about the committee and a map of public art in the city.

5. Unfinished Business

A. Artistic Bus Shelter

Lisa Hilton shared a list of bus stops on Olive Boulevard with ridership numbers, stating that St. Louis Metro is planning to revamp bus stops west of I-270 in 2023 and that would be a good area to look at first for an artistic bus shelter. Robert Morrissey stated that the bus shelter must provide shelter from the weather. Lisa Hilton said an example could be a standard bus shelter but with etched glass. Dan Tierney provided background information on the city's effort several years ago to commission an artistic bus shelter outside of the Danforth Plant Science Center.

Lisa Hilton stated that the committee could also consider creating a public space around an existing bus stop. The Committee discussed the concept of identifying/creating an identity for the city.

B. CCA Mural Project

Dan Tierney provided background information on the Creative Communities Alliance, the organization that coordinates the Sculpture on the Move program. The organization is brainstorming a possible traveling mural project where an artist would paint a mural on plywood for each participating city, and the collection of murals would travel city to city.



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The Committee discussed the logistics of the project that would need to be addressed before agreeing to support participation in the project, such as time of year and duration of the installation.

C. International Films

Lisa Hilton asked if the Committee should ask local film festivals to show films at a theater in Creve Coeur as a way to bring additional arts/culture into the city for the community to enjoy. Dan Tierney asked if it would be possible to bring back opera nights at the movie theater, something that used to be offered before Covid.
