4. Unfinished Business

A. Arbor Day Recap

Lisa Hilton provided a recap of the Arts Committee's contribution to Arbor Day, which included a coloring table. Lisa requested that the City powerwash the sculpture at Millennium Park and purchase plaques for artwork in the city that does not have plaques.

B. Artistic Bus Shelter

Sara Friedman shared a photo of an artistic bus shelter with artistic elements around and attached to the structure, in comparison to previous discussion where the shelter itself is artistic. The Committee discussed whether there was value in pursuing this idea and whether city funds should be spent on a project like this. The Committee asked staff liaison Melissa Bradford to prepare a memo summarizing the project idea for the Committee to review.

C. CCA Mural Project

Lisa Hilton suggested that the Creative Communities Alliance (CCA) consider having one single mural to make logistics easier. The Committee agreed that logistical concerns would need to be addressed by the CCA before the Committee could recommend participation in this program.

D. International Films

No further discussion was held. The Committee agreed to remove this item from future agendas.

5. New Business



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A. Sculpture on the Move Update

Staff liaison Melissa Bradford stated that the sculpture located at the Dielmann Recreation Complex has been removed after completing its two-year term through the Sculpture on the Move program. The incoming sculpture selected for the next two-year term will be installed the first week of May.

B. Little Free Art Gallery

Lisa Hilton shared information about a concept known as Little Free Art Galleries, similar to Little Free Libraries but with artwork. The Committee agreed it would be an engaging addition to a park and suggested Millennium Park. The Committee asked staff liaison Melissa Bradford to write a memo summarizing this project idea for the Committee to review.

6. Comments from the Public

7. Business from Members

Lisa Hilton stated she will not be running for chair again. Voting for chair and vice chair is held annually at the July meeting.

Robert Morrissey asked if anyone had ever considered hosting an art gallery in Tappmeyer Homestead. Melissa Bradford stated that the Tappmeyer Foundation is always looking for new ways to get foot traffic in the house.

Lisa Hilton asked if more public art could be added to the Government Center when it's renovated, similar to the City of Manchester or Chesterfield. Melissa Bradford stated she would ask staff about including arts into the discussion of facility renovations.

Staff liaison Melissa Bradford reminded members of the ice arena questionnaire available on the city's website. The next meeting is scheduled for May 25, 2022.
