2. Discussion of Greenheart Partners Presentation

Committee members discussed the presentation by Greenheart Partners from the previous committee meeting. Committee members provided questions for Greenheart Partners to address before making a recommendation to the City Council regarding their services. The suggested questions related to the scope of their greenhouse gas inventory and examples of other clients. Staff liaison Melissa Bradford stated the committee would need to consider how this greenhouse gas inventory would be different from the one conducted in 2014 and what the city would do with the reported information. The Committee discussed how the pandemic may have impacted greenhouse gas levels.

Staff liaison Melissa Bradford stated that she would be submitting a grant application through the St. Louis-Jefferson Solid Waste Management District to fund the printing and mailing of recycling education magnets to Creve Coeur households. If the city were awarded the grant, the grant would reimburse 90% of project costs. The project is estimated to cost \$7,000. The Energy and Environment Committee would assist with developing the educational messaging on the magnets, with input from Republic Services as well.

4. Electric Vehicles

Hal Harris provided information about how Webster Groves has approved the purchase of the city's first electric vehicles for the police department.

NEW BUSINESS

Hal Harris suggested the committee consider recommending that the city be a municipal partner with Grow Solar in 2023. Grow Solar St. Louis is a public education and group purchasing program for residential and commercial solar to make installing solar more affordable. As a municipal partner, the city would help promote the Grow Solar educational sessions to educate residents about the benefits of solar panels. The committee voted to recommend the city be a municipal partner with Grow Solar St. Louis in 2023. Greg Campbell motioned, Donna Spence seconded, the motion passed with 6 ayes.

Council liaison Nicole Greer provided details on upcoming Ward 2 & 3 town halls. She also stated that the QuikTrip Supreme Court argument was heard on October 26, 2022. The City also recently passed a drive-through restaurant ordinance amendment.
